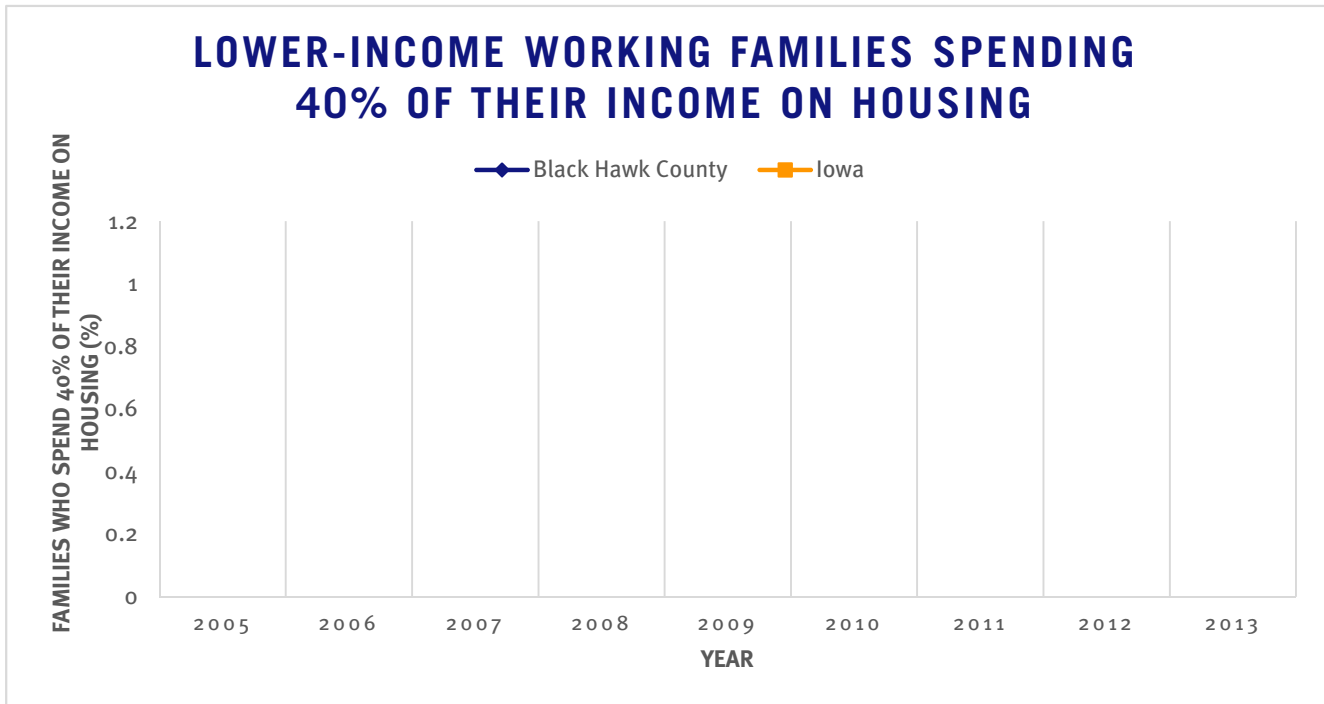

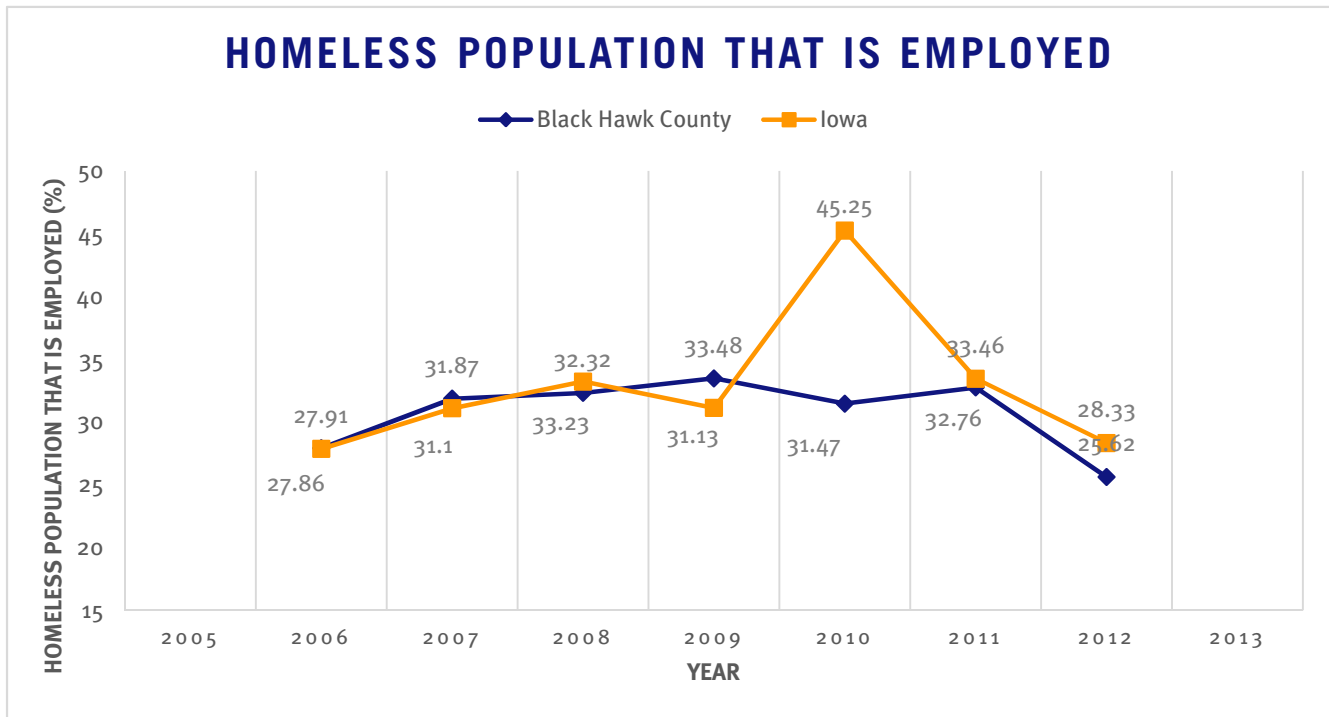

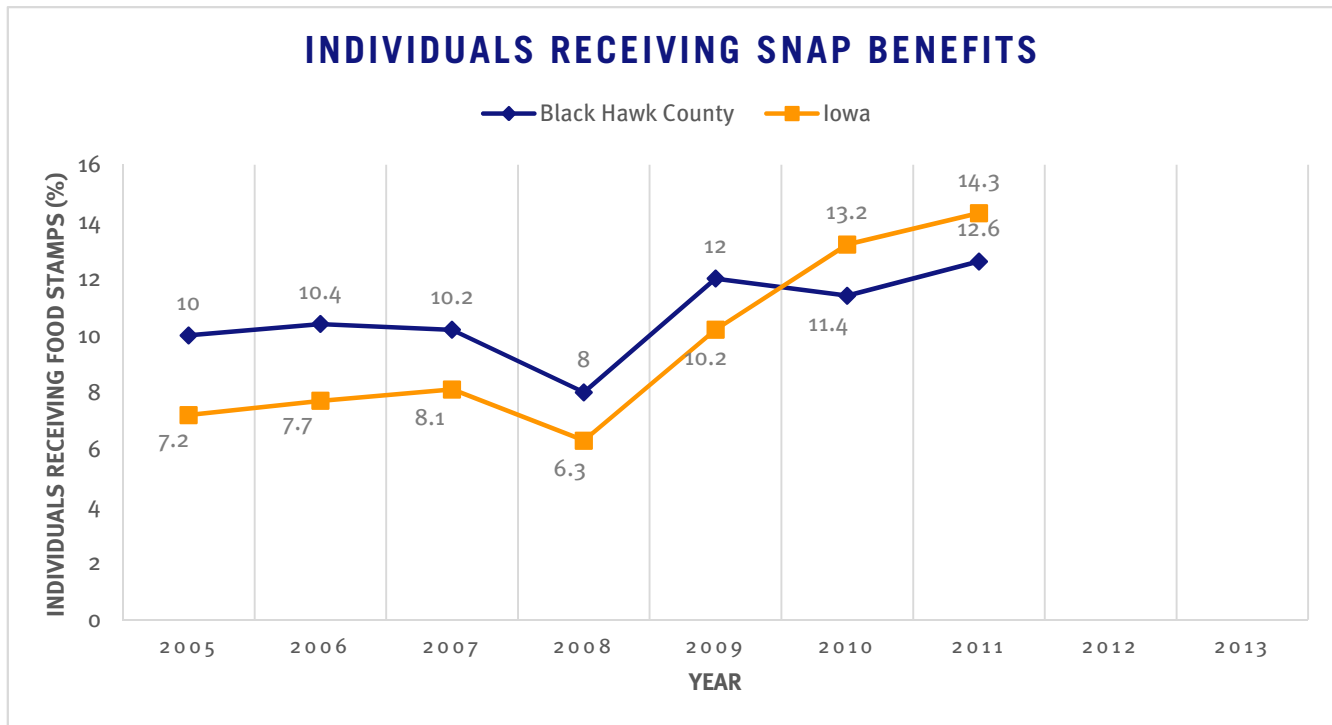

Percentage of individuals receiving financial assistance for food during the year (nationally known as the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, or SNAP)

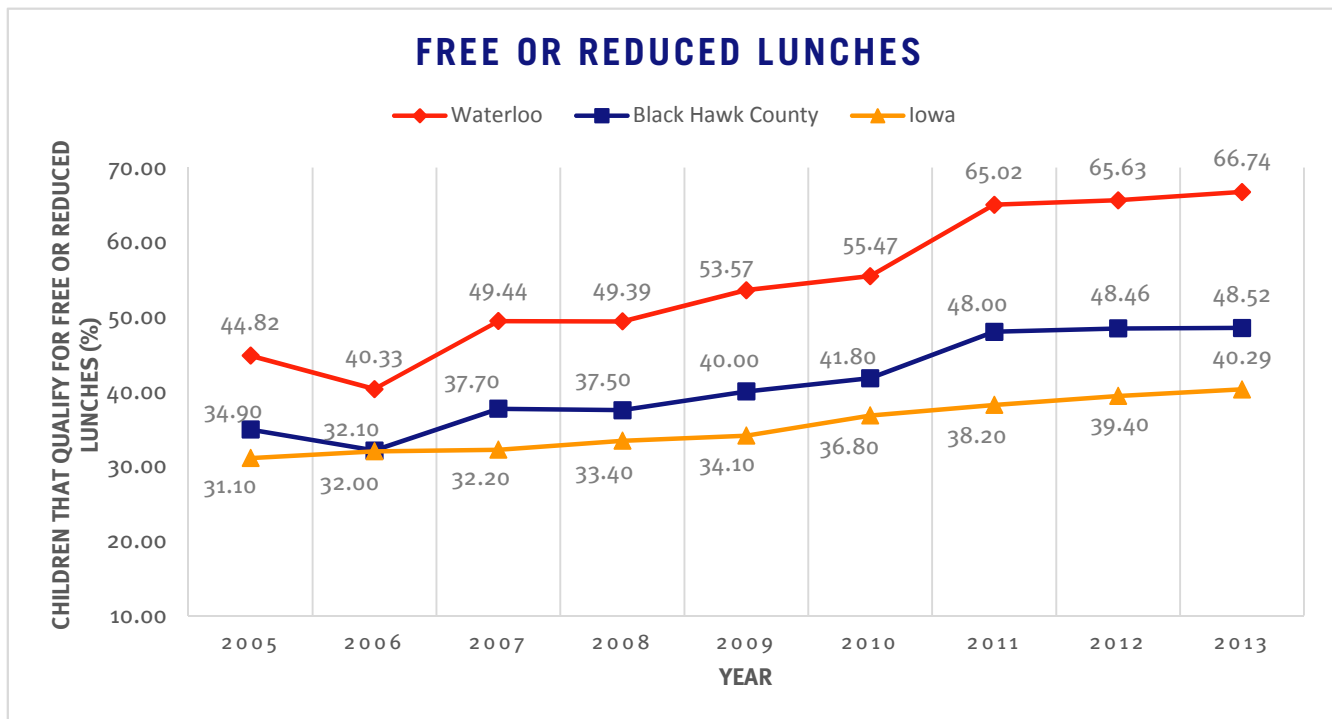

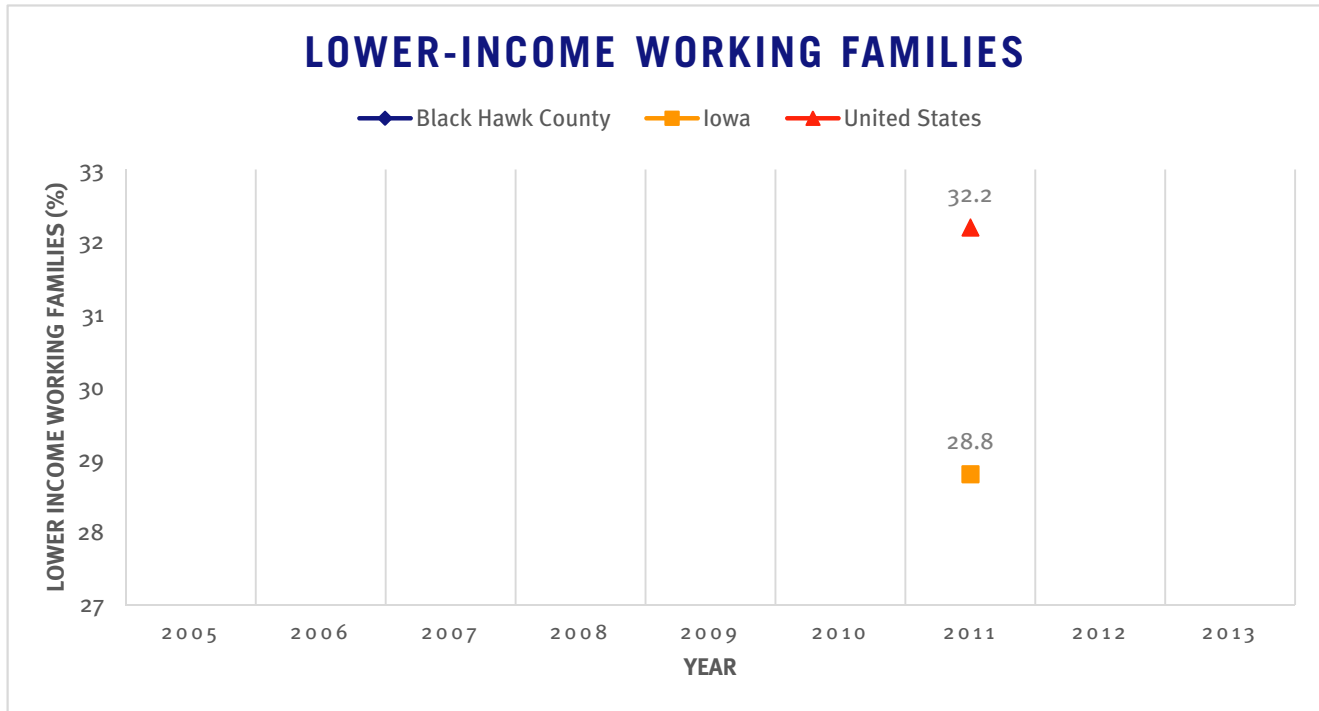

PERCENTAGE OF LOWER-INCOME WORKING FAMILIES

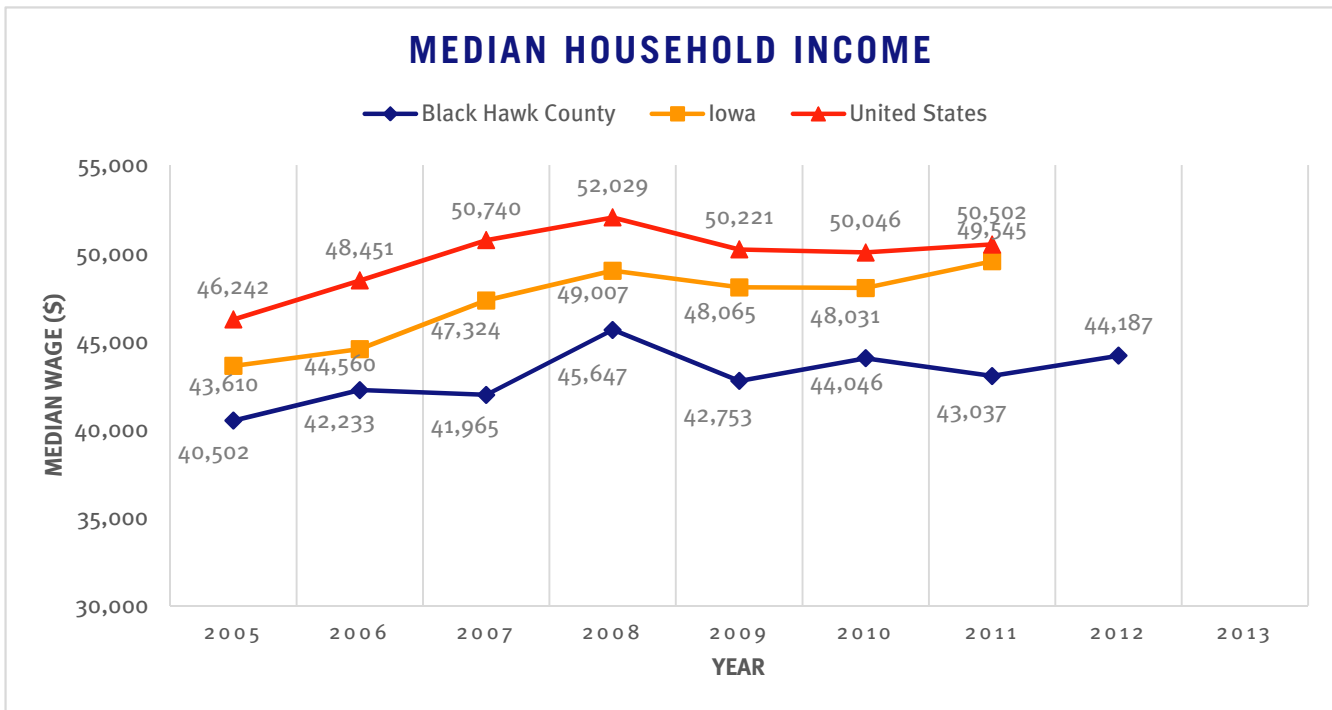

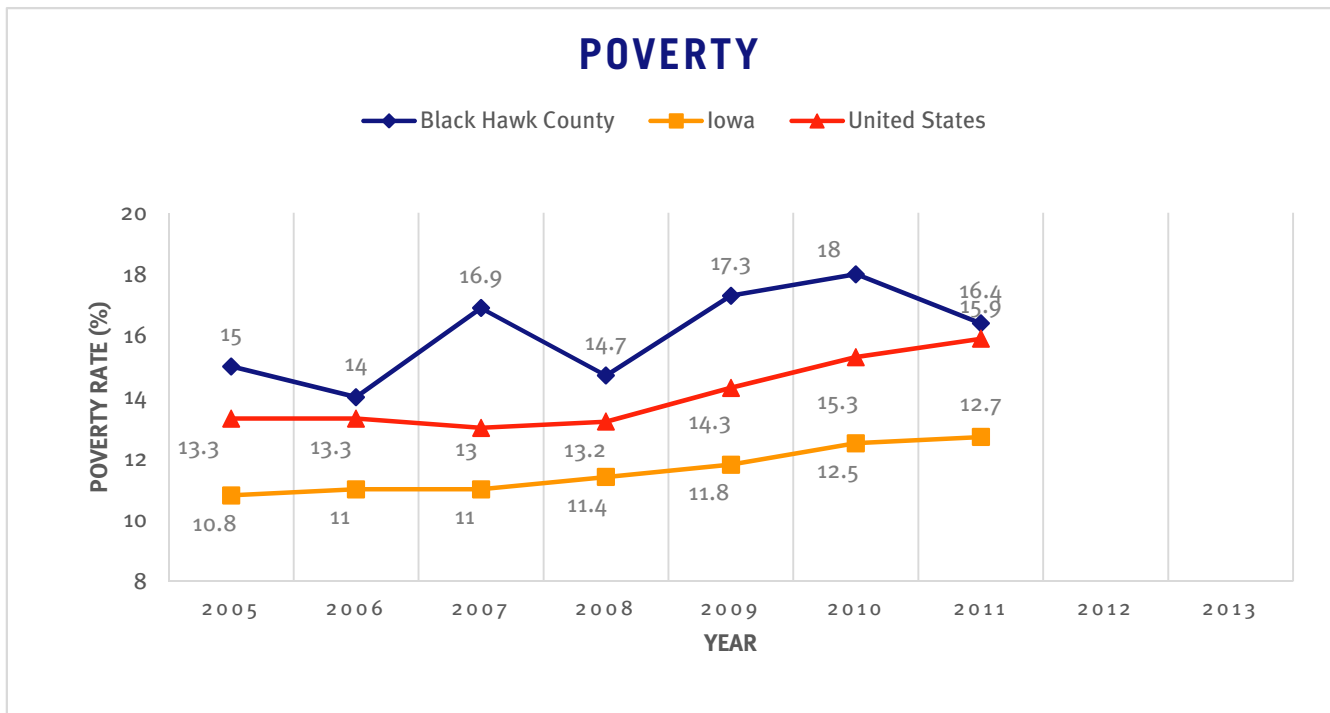

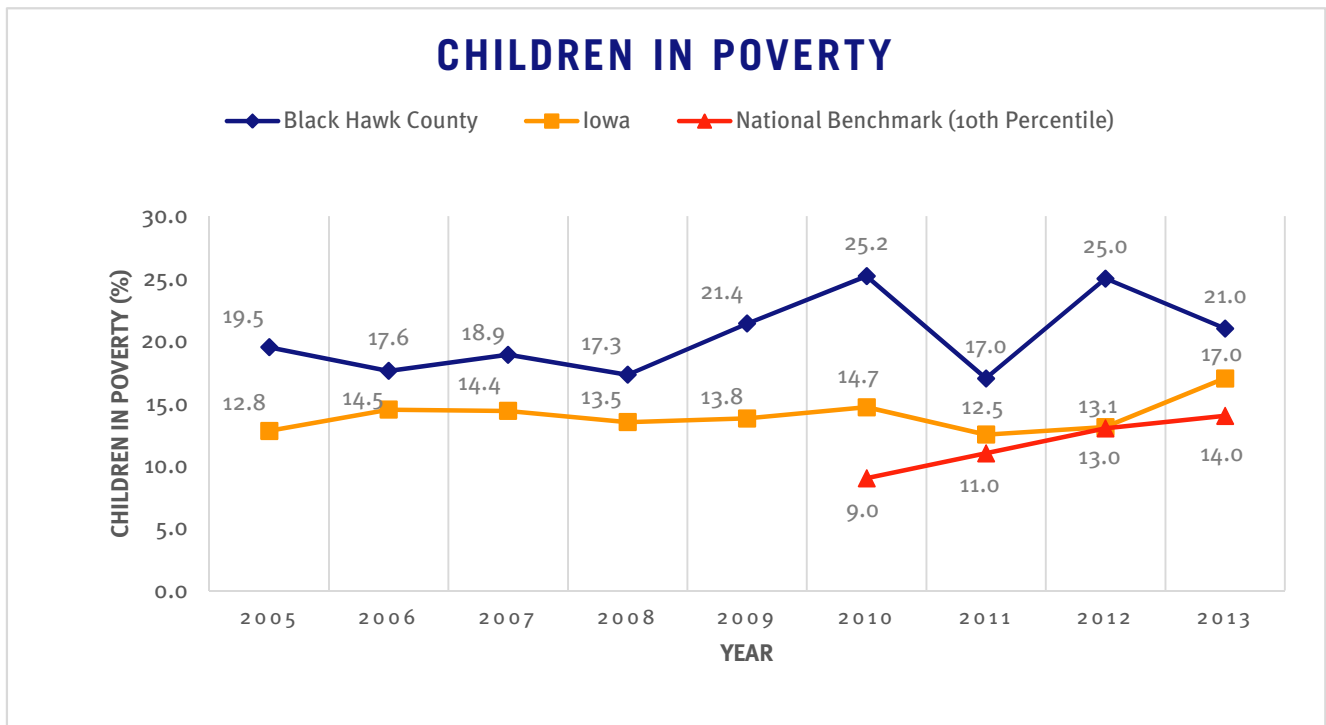

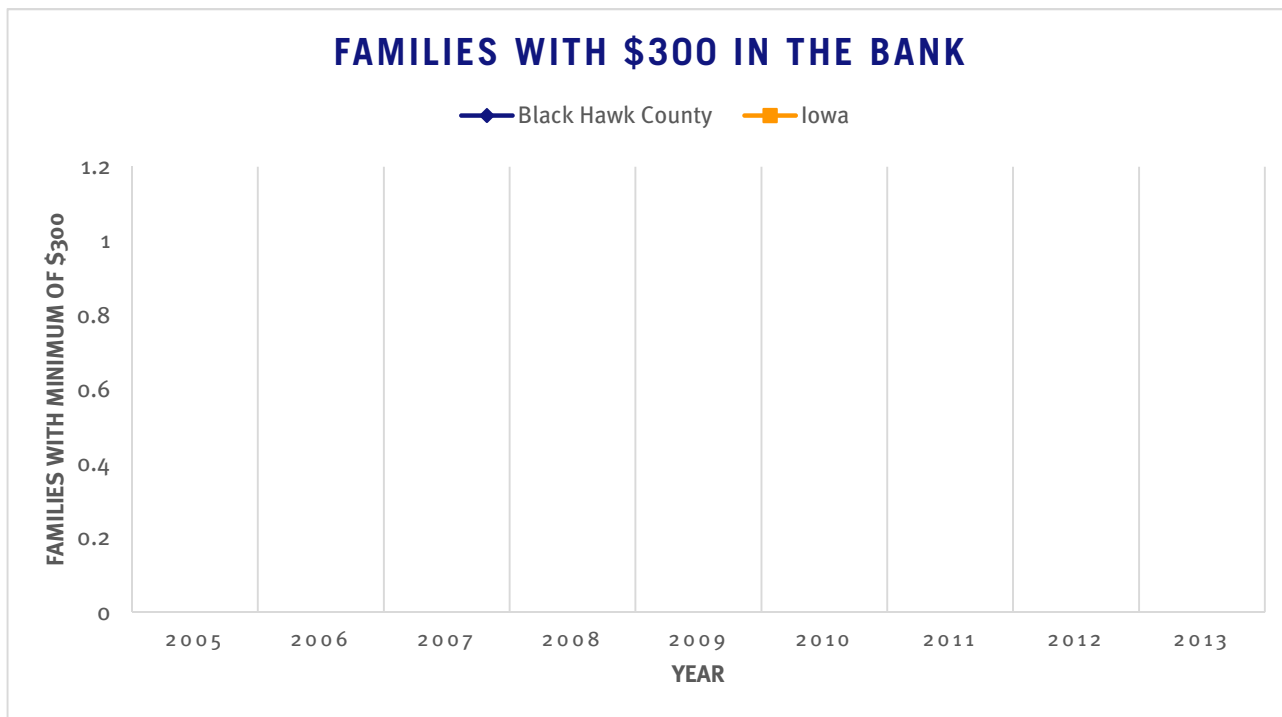

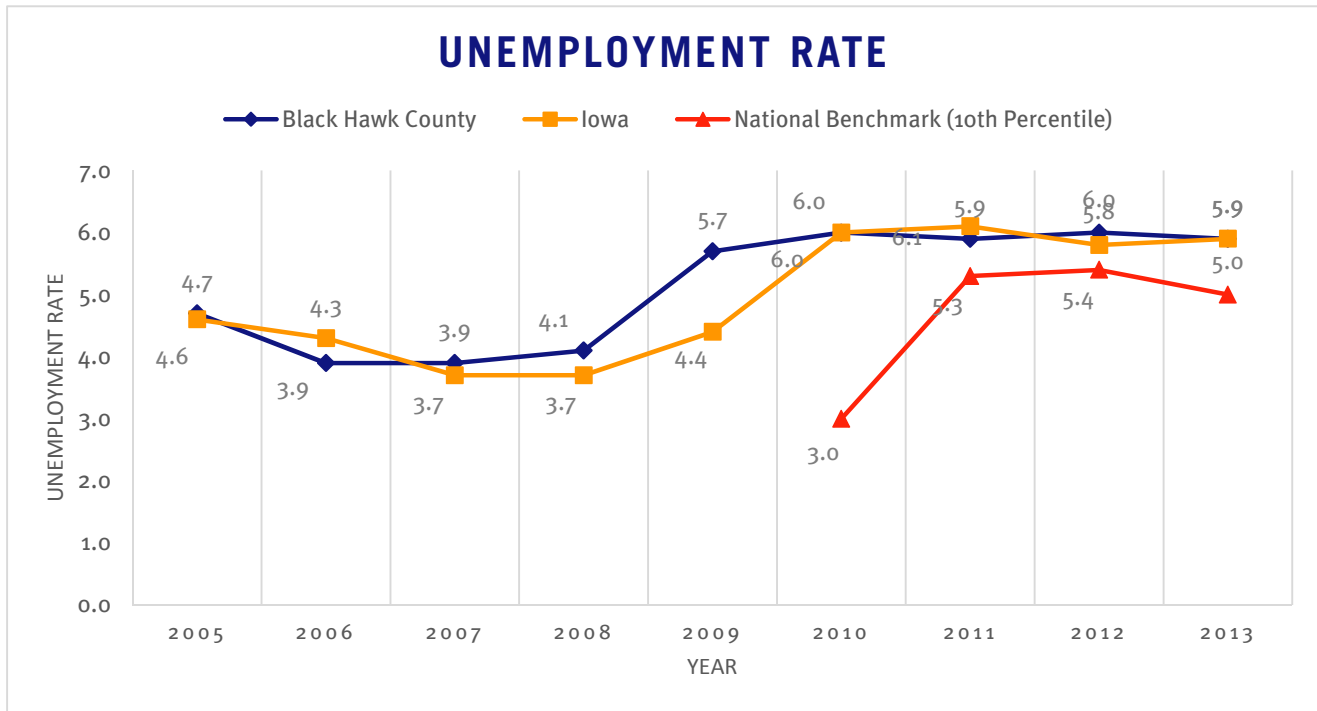

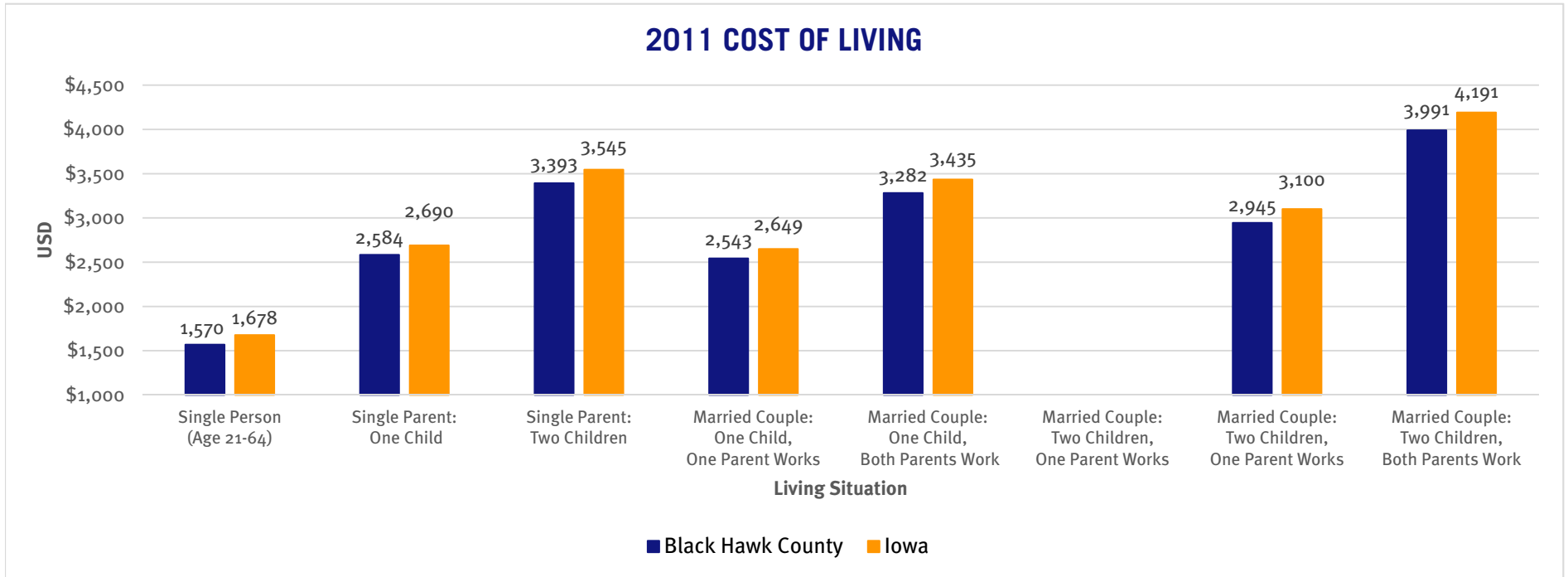
