After graduating from the Momentum Program, William secured a job with a local contractor and was thriving. But within a year, the contract ended, leaving him unemployed. In the midst of this setback, William suffered the profound loss of both his parents. Grief and uncertainty weighed heavily on him, and he found himself struggling to stay sober and resist old patterns of coping. He left the state to go on a journey to rediscover himself. He returned to the state homeless and falling behind on rent-he remembered the support and lessons from his Momentum training. Knowing that "the opposite of addiction is connection," determined not to give up, William returned to One City United. In just one month, with the help of their network and resources, he secured stable housing, paid off his debt, and found new employment. Today, he continues working with the One City team, receiving coaching as he rebuilds his life and prepares to reunite with his son. William's journey is a powerful reminder of why One City United and to Momentum program place so much emphasis on building relationships - they are the cornerstone of
